Courses to enrich your understanding and sharpen your skills

As a student in our dance program, you'll take your technique and skill to the next level. Our ballet faculty are all ABT® National Training Curriculum Certified Teacher Level 7. On campus, you'll practice, learn and perform in small classes held in state-of-the-art facilities.

Here are just some of the courses you'll take when you major in dance:

- **Dance History and Criticism:** Learn the history and evolution of dance through the ages. Understand how dance is interconnected with other artistic, historical, political and social developments. Expand your definition of dance and analyze its place in current society. Develop your critical eye as a performer, choreographer and active audience member.
- **Dance Improvisation:** Explore the creative potential of spontaneous movement through internally and externally driven and structured improvisation in order to study spatial awareness and further develop the body's motor system.
- **Dance Theory and Composition:** Analyze, contribute and fully investigate the choreographic process through the use of improvisation and dance composition tools. Become a movement researcher through exploration of curiosity and by confronting habits and preferences. Reflect on new and different movement strategies for creative practice and performance application through varied audience perspectives.
