#### Technique

The dance faculty works with students to re-evaluate technique and explore new approaches to training at a high level. This reevaluation includes training with optimal anatomical alignment that supports injury-free dancing.

#### Performances

Dance majors at UW-Stevens Point perform dance, choreograph dance, create multimedia work and present original research. Students also develop the ability to work as a part of an ensemble, the ability to work openly and honestly with other dancers, the ability to be flexible in the artistic process with choreographers, directors, rehearsal assistants, and the ability to collaborate successfully with other artists and technicians.
